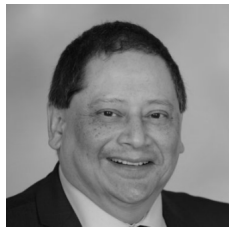

A View from Ryedale House



The search for a new Chief Executive for Ryedale District Council is over, with a suitable candidate identified. However, the appointment has to be confirmed at Full Council meeting before the name of the successful candidate can be released.

As I write this article, the Full Council meeting to confirm the appointment has yet to take place, so I am unable to provide the name of the candidate. Paradoxically, by the time you

read this issue of the Warbler, the appointment will have been made, and it will be old news.

There has been concern regarding the possible closure of swimming clubs within the Ryedale District and more locally the Derwent Valley Swimming Club that uses Norton swimming pool to teach children valuable swimming skills. This potential issue was discussed at the Policy & Resources committee before being passed to the Overview & Scrutiny committee for their assessment.

It is Ryedale District Council's intention to keep swimming clubs open in consultation with Everyone Active as these clubs provide a valuable service to children within the community and will be debated at Full Council meeting to be held next week.

It should be remembered that at a time when Norton Swimming Pool was under threat of closure owing to a lack of funds, Everyone Active helped to keep the swimming pool open and provided the equipment needed.

As I am not a member for either of the committees involved, it is my understanding that Ryedale District Council will be seeking to negotiate with Everyone Active to arrive at an equitable solution for all parties concerned and to prevent any swimming clubs from closing.

As with the announcement of the new chief executive for Ryedale District Council, by the time you read this article, the outcome of the discussion will probably be known.
