Topic of the moment for all councils and public bodies has to be GDPR – General Data Protection Regulations, but do we love or loath it? At first glance it seems like another layer of bureaucracy to negotiate our way through but let's take a closer look because many of us now use the internet, social media and smart phones on a regular basis. We are all targeted by very specific adverts tailored to our personal needs, so perhaps its right that we should be asking the questions how this tailored information has been acquired and who has the right to hold and more importantly, use our personal data.

We have always had rights under the Data Protection Act since 1984 and this was upgraded in 1998 but 20 years on, the digital world is a very different place. I believe that this increased protection is a good thing, but it poses some awkward questions in relation to Local Authority service delivery.

NYCC deliver over 700 services and each piece of personal information gathered to help each resident has to be held specifically for the reason acquired and with the owner's consent. But what happens if by cross referencing several information silos, we can see improvements for residents or perhaps even help to prevent a life limiting disease through public health service interaction, where do we draw the line?

I welcome the safeguarding of our information but will leave that broader question hanging because there is a lot more thinking through to be done here and a lot more help to be directed to small groups such as Parish Councils.
