A View from Ryedale House



Earlier this year I highlighted an issue that was brought to my attention by the chair of one of our Parish Councils concerning proposed changes by the York Teaching Hospital NHS Foundation Trust that would affect the way healthcare services got deployed within our region.

For residents who generally access Scarborough hospital, some of the proposed changes include:

1. The reduction or stopping of emergency surgery and the moving of selected routine elective surgery to a different centre like York, Hull or James Cook. These changes could lead to having to travel extended distances for the patient and or family members in the

2) the reduction of Obstetric cover in favour of a midwifery-led team. In the event of complications, the patient would probably be relocated to a different region,

3) The downgrading of accident and emergency to a minor injuries unit led by Nurse Practitioners. Scarborough hospital is a trauma unit and is some distance from other hospitals. A downgrade could place the local population at risk.

4) The reassignment of outpatient appointments into primary care where there are already delays in waiting for GP appointments

5) Closing paediatric wards would force residents to travel to York.

Residents without cars could be severely affected by the proposed changes and having to rely on public transport would bring its own difficulties.

Residents should lobby our MP, York Trust and their local clinical commissioning groups to prevent the proposed changes to Scarborough Hospital that could long-term risk implications to the residents of our villages.
