## A View from County Hall



If the Environment Agency are to be believed, the recent events in The Dales will be the heaviest rainfall ever recorded in the county with an unprecedented amount of water falling. Somewhere in the region of 113 mm of rain fell in a 3 hour period, greater than had been experienced in the infamous flooding of Boscastle a few years ago. I am told that large boulders being carried by the volume and force of water were hurled at the Grinton bridge structure taking it out as surely as it had been struck by a missile.

Though we have less rain on the eastern side of the county, it is clear that weather patterns are changing and if we look at past history we have been by no means exempt from unusually heavy deluges. There are obvious implications for our Wolds villages with the Gipsy Race running through them and those A64 villages at the foot of the Wolds, where we know the geography compounds the effect of any heavy downfall.

As a council we recognise the affects of global warming, an Executive sub-group and Scrutiny task Group concentrating on climate change has already been put in place and the Authority has made progress in reducing carbon emissions. Along with these measures, I think it is imperative that we ensure our existing drainage infrastructure is well maintained and that our water courses are managed to enable full capacity.

Riparian owners (those whose property boundaries abut the water course) have responsibility for maintaining it however in residential areas, property owners are often unaware of this detail or anxious about what they are permitted to do within it. This can lead to a variance in standard of maintenance and obvious implications for everyone. I have successfully set up groups of volunteers in some of my Thornton Dale Ward villages to address this problem and I am happy to discuss this with any Wolds Ward villages. It is worth bearing in mind that when dealing with water courses and volunteers, the volume of volunteers is directly proportionate to the volume of sunshine, so best to set up these groups whilst the weather holds.

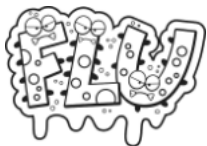

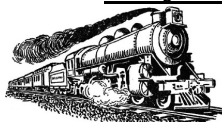
