# A View from County Hall

Once a year, we have our important "JOBO" day (Joint Board meeting) when the executive members of NYCC meet with the CEO and his directors. We are in effect shut in a room to discuss where we have been and where we are going as a council. Of course we meet on a regular weekly basis but on our JOBO day we look at the broader landscape, thrash out new ideas and look for opportunities and themes.

When I first joined the council in 2011, the four year theme was "One Council" the entire infrastructure of the council was pulled out and streamlined. We then moved on to "2020 North Yorkshire" which saw a more service based restructure, looking at efficiencies through new and innovative ways of service delivery. Our "Beyond 2020" is a working extension of the past theme because after cutting the budget by around a third and having the continual pressures of a demand lead service, we are just about cut to the bone and still have to plug a £14 million gap in our budget.

So whoever our new Prime Minister turns out to be. I hope that beyond the obvious priority for them to address, they will look with some urgency at the fairer funding of Local Government because ultimately it is where the likes of you and me feel most directly the effects of a stall in the system.

# Bus service 190 - Foxholes to Malton



The Parish Councils in the Great Wolds Valley have been advised by North Yorkshire County Council (NYCC) Passenger Transport section to inform us that the contracts for

the subsidised local bus services are due for renewal in April 2020. As part of the renewal process, NYCC is seeking comments on these services, so that it can be better informed when preparing tenders for new contracts. One of the services listed for renewal is the 190 service from Foxholes to Malton.

A few years ago when the Post B us was axed, the Parish Councils lobbied NYCC to ensure that the valuable service that had been provided by the Post Bus was not lost with the result that NYCC now provides the subsidised service directly.

Your Parish Council will be writing to support the renewal of the service, but it also needs those who use the service to write to NYCC to let them know how vital the service is to the residents in the valley. 
